I became aware this morning that the computers operate on U.S. current of 115 Volts. Zambia's power grid provides 240 Volts. While a converter works on relatively non-sensitive equipment like refrigerators, it does not work on sensitive products like computers. We in Zambia experience frequent, greatly fluctuating power surges and outages, which have proven to be very destructive to computers and similar equipment that are attached to converters.

Therefore, we must reconsider your very generous offer. We hope that you understand this dilemma and will continue to give consideration to us when and if workable opportunities become available.

Once again, my sincere thanks to you, Mr. Fallai, for your interest in our activities to restore dignity and true democracy to Zambia.
