The Platform Party members walk to their chairs and remain
standing. The GRAND MARSHAL moves to the microphone.)

GRAND MARSHAL FARIS: **MR. VICE PRESIDENT, THE**

(The GRAND MARSHAL peaks his cap. The VICE PRESIDENT returns the gesture. The GRAND MARSHAL moves to his chair and remains standing. The VICE PRESIDENT moves to the lectern microphone.)

LISTED IN YOUR COMMENCEMENT PROGRAM.**

**THERE IS ONE PERSON ON THE PLATFORM, HOWEVER,
WHOM I WISH TO INTRODUCE TO YOU NOW, AND I ASK
THAT HE STAND TO RECEIVE OUR GREETING: THE
DISTINGUISHED CHANCELLOR OF THE UNIVERSITY
AND PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF BUSINESS
ADMINISTRTION, DR. HERMAN B WELLS. (VICE
PRESIDENT leads applause.)**

(VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO returns gesture and resumes seat.)

MS. BROWNE (addressing MR. STONER): **TRUSTEE STONER,
INSCRIBED UPON THIS SCROLL ARE THE NAMES OF
EVERY MEMBER OF THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 1988.**

► **I REQUEST THAT EACH NAME BE FORMALLY ADDED
TO THE LIST OF ALUMNI OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY.**

(MS. BROWNE hands scroll to MR. STONER, who steps forward
to receive it.)

MS. BROWNE continues: **WE PLEDGE OUR CONTINUING
ALLEGIANCE AND WE ASK THE ALUMNI BODY TO
DIRECT OUR SERVICE.**

MR. STONER: **THANK YOU, PATRICIA** (addressing MISS
GRAY): **PRESIDENT GRAY, THE TRUSTEES OF INDIANA
UNIVERSITY PRESENT TO YOU FOR ADMISSION INTO
THE BODY OF ALUMNI THESE CANDIDATES FOR
DEGREES. ► THESE MEN AND WOMEN WILL BE THE
UNIVERSITY'S REPRESENTATIVES IN MANY FIELDS OF**

**ENDEAVOR THROUGHOUT THE WORLD. ► WE HOPE
THAT THEIR WORK WILL REFLECT HONOR UPON AND
BRING GREATER STRENGTH TO THE UNIVERSITY THEY

(MR. STONER hands scroll to MISS GRAY, who steps forward to receive it.)

MISS GRAY (addressing MR. STONER): **TRUSTEE STONER,
WE ACCEPT INTO THE FELLOWSHIP OF ALUMNI THESE
CANDIDATES FOR DEGREES FROM INDIANA
UNIVERSITY.**

MISS GRAY continues (addressing the candidates): **MEMBERS
OF THE GRADUATING CLASS OF 1988, WE WELCOME
YOU TO THE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION AND WE WISH YOU
WELL. ► THE STRENGTH OF THE ASSOCIATION AND
OF THIS UNIVERSITY DEPENDS UPON THE STRENGTH
OF EACH OF YOU.**

**THE ALUMNI JOIN YOU IN YOUR PLEDGE OF SUPPORT FOR
A UNIVERSITY COMMITTED TO GREATER SERVICE TO
HUMANKIND.**

(IU representatives return to their seats and remain standing, and VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO moves to the lectern.)

VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO: TO THE NEWEST INDIANA UNIVERSITY ALUMNI, I EXTEND CONGRATULATIONS AND A HEARTY WELCOME. ► IN ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF YOUR INDUCTION INTO THE ALUMNI FAMILY, I ASK MR. RUBY, M.B.A., 1959, INDIANA UNIVERSITY, TO LEAD THE NEW IU GRADUATES, AND ALL OF US IN SINGING THE ALMA MATER SONG, "HAIL TO OLD I.U." ► THE WORDS ARE ON PAGE 2 OF YOUR PROGRAM. ► MR. RUBY. ► WILL EVERYONE PLEASE STAND.

(All rise and doff caps.)

(MR. RUBY directs "Hail to Old I.U." then motions the audience to resume seats.)

VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO: PLEASE BE SEATED (if audience is standing.) ► I NEXT INVITE THE REPRESENTATIVES OF PURDUE UNIVERSITY TO CONDUCT THE PURDUE

INDUCTION.

(MS. CHESNUT hands scroll to MR. KARL, who steps forward to
receive it.)

MS. CHESNUT continues: **WE PLEDGE OUR CONTINUING
ALLEGIANCE TO OUR ALMA MATER AND WE ASK THE
ALUMNI BODY TO DIRECT OUR SERVICE.**

MR. KARL: **THANK YOU, ELIZABETH.** (Addressing the
graduates): **ON BEHALF OF THE MORE THAN 230,000
PURDUE ALUMNI THROUGHOUT THE WORLD, PLEASE
ACCEPT MY SINCERE CONGRATULATIONS ON THE
COMPLETION OF AN IMPORTANT PART OF YOUR
FORMAL EDUCATION. ► AS YOU TAKE YOUR PLACE
AMONG US, WE INVITE YOU TO SHARE OUR PRIDE IN
PURDUE, IN HER HERITAGE, AND IN HER FUTURE.**

AND WAS A MEMBER OF THE PURDUE GLEE CLUB.**

(MR. RUBY directs "HAIL PURDUE" then motions the audience to
resume seats.)

(VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO returns to lectern.)

**DR. STEVEN C. BEERING, PRESIDENT OF PURDUE
UNIVERSITY, TO COME FORWARD.**

(PRESIDENT BEERING rises, peaks cap, and goes to lectern.

VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO returns the gesture and returns to his
seat.)

**PRESIDENT BEERING: WE ARE EXTREMELY PLEASED
TODAY TO HONOR A DISTINGUISHED ALUMNUS OF
PURDUE UNIVERSITY. ► I NOW REQUEST DR. R.
BRUCE RENDA, DEAN OF THE PURDUE UNIVERSITY
SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY, TO
ESCORT OUR CANDIDATE FOR AN HONORARY DEGREE
TO THE LECTERN. ► I ALSO ASK DR. JOHN E.
KADLEC, GRAND MARSHAL OF PURDUE UNIVERSITY,
TO ASSIST IN THE HOODING.**

(DEAN RENDA rises and peaks cap. PRESIDENT BEERING
returns the gesture. DEAN RENDA escorts MR. DEMARS to the
lectern. DEAN RENDA stands at the side microphone. MR.

DEMARS is between DEAN RENDA and PRESIDENT BEERING.

MR. DEMARS removes his cap.)

DEAN RENDA: IT IS A PRIVILEGE AND HONOR TO

PRESENT TO YOU MR. RICHARD B. DEMARS FOR

RECOGNITION BY THE UNIVERSITY TODAY. ► MR.

DEMARS IS THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF ONE OF

INDIANA'S LEADING CONSTRUCTION FIRMS. ► HE

HAS GENEROUSLY DEVOTED HIMSELF TO ADVANCING

THE INTEREST OF HIS COMMUNITY AND HIS STATE.

► HE HAS SERVED AS A DIRECTOR OR OFFICER FOR

COMMUNITY SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS,

CORPORATIONS, FOUNDATIONS AND EDUCATIONAL

INSTITUTIONS. ► HIS LONG RECORD OF SERVICE TO

OTHERS PLACES HIM IN THE FIRST RANK OF

DISTINGUISHED CITIZENS IN INDIANA. ► IT IS MOST

FITTING THAT PURDUE UNIVERSITY HONOR RICHARD

DEMARS BY CONFERRING UPON HIM THE DEGREE

**PRESIDENT BEERING: RICHARD B. DEMARS, PURDUE
UNIVERSITY OFFERS ITS HEARTY CONGRATULATIONS
AND ADMIRATION TO YOU. ► YOUR UNSELFISH
SERVICE TO OTHERS SERVES AS A MODEL OF
RESPONSIBLE AND EFFECTIVE CITIZENSHIP. ► I
HAVE THE PRIVILEGE TO EXERCISE THE AUTHORITY

hands with MR. DEMARS. DEAN RENDA escorts MR. DEMARS to his seat and then returns to his own seat. PRESIDENT BEERING, DR. KADLEC, and MR. BURTON return to their respective seats.)

(VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO rises and moves to lectern.)

VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO: I NOW REQUEST PRESIDENT THOMAS EHRLICH OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY TO COME FORWARD.

(PRESIDENT EHRLICH rises, peaks cap, and moves to the lectern. VICE PRESIDENT BEPKO returns the gesture and resumes his seat.)

PRESIDENT EHRLICH: I ASK DR. GLENN ^L~~IRWIN~~ IRWIN, ~~DR.~~ ^{DEAN} ~~PROFESSOR~~ ^{THE SCHOOL OF} EMERITUS OF MEDICINE, TO ESCORT OUR FIRST CANDIDATE FOR AN HONORARY DEGREE. ► I ASK DR. ^R~~MR.~~ GENE FARIS, GRAND MARSHAL OF INDIANA UNIVERSITY, TO ASSIST.

(DR. IRWIN rises and peaks cap. PRESIDENT EHRLICH returns
the gesture. DR. IRWIN escorts PRESIDENT ^LBEERING to the
lectern. DR. IRWIN stands at the side microphone. PRESIDENT

EHRLICH. PRESIDENT BEERING removes his cap.)

DR. IRWIN (partially facing PRESIDENT EHRLICH): **MR.**

**PRESIDENT, IT IS AN HONOR TO PRESENT TO YOU DR.
STEVEN C. BEERING, PRESIDENT OF PURDUE
UNIVERSITY. ► DR. BEERING HAS CONTRIBUTED HIS
VISION AND BROAD PERSPECTIVES TO
STRENGTHENING RESOURCES FOR EDUCATION IN
INDIANA AND ENHANCING COOPERATION AMONG THE
STATE'S COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES. ► AS DEAN
OF THE INDIANA UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE
DURING AN IMPORTANT DECADE OF ITS HISTORY, HE
SIGNIFICANTLY ADVANCED THE TEACHING,
RESEARCH, AND CLINICAL PROGRAMS OF THE
SCHOOL. ► IN THAT POSITION HE WAS ALSO A**

LEADER IN MANY NATIONAL MEDICAL ORGANIZATIONS, WHERE HE EXERTED AN ENDURING INFLUENCE ON PROGRAMS AND POLICIES IN MEDICAL EDUCATION, BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH, AND PATIENT CARE.

IT IS APPROPRIATE THAT INDIANA UNIVERSITY HONOR STEVEN C. BEERING BY CONFERRING ON HIM THE HONORARY DEGREE DOCTOR OF SCIENCE.
