CLASS OF 1992, YOU GRADUATE WITH APPLAUSE AND CHEERS, SIGHS, AND EVEN TEARS FROM THE REST OF US -- YOUR FAMILY, YOUR FRIENDS, AND YOUR UNIVERSITIES. 

YOU ALSO LEAVE YOUR YEARS HERE WITH OUR PRAYERS.

THOSE YEARS HAVE BEEN A TIME FOR

EXPLORATION -- OF INTELLECT, OF MORALITY,

AND OF SELF. WE PRAY YOU CONTINUE YOUR

VOYAGE OF DISCOVERY IN ALL THREE REALMS.

KNOWLEDGE IS THE COMMON DENOMINATOR
THAT LINKS THEM, AND LEARNING IS A SUPERB

LEARN WHY THE WORLD

WAGS AND WHAT WAGS IT. 
THAT IS THE ONLY
THING WHICH THE MIND CAN NEVER EXHAUST,
NEVER ALIENATE, NEVER BE TORTURED BY,

RATHER, IT IS THE MORALITY THAT HOLDS SACRED THE DIGNITY OF EACH PERSON AND CELEBRATES THE DIVERSITY OF ALL PEOPLE. 
WE PRAY YOU WILL CONTINUE TO BE ENRICHED BY REACHING OUT TO THOSE WHO CAN HELP YOU GROW. 
WE ALL DEVELOP IN DIRECT

PROPORTION TO OUR INVOLVEMENT WITH INDIVIDUALS WHO CHALLENGE THE COMFORT OF OUR MENTAL COCOONS AND HELP US TO OUTGROW THOSE COCOONS.

PARTICULARLY IMPORTANT IN CHALLENGING YOU AND HELPING YOU GROW. I HOPE YOU WILL STAY IN TOUCH WITH YOUR FRIENDS ON THE FACULTY. GUR UNIVERSITIES ARE BLESSED WITH GREAT TEACHER/SCHOLARS -- WOMEN AND MEN WHO DEDICATE THEIR LIVES TO THE PURSUIT OF KNOWLEDGE AND TO SHARING THAT PURSUIT WITH STUDENTS.

EXAMPLES OF IU SOUTHEAST'S GREAT
TEACHERS ARE THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN

HONORED WITH TEACHING AWARDS. 

THE VERY FIRST IU SOUTHEAST FACULTY MEMBER EVER TO RECEIVE AN ALL-UNIVERSITY TEACHING AWARD -- IN 1972 -- IS PROFESSOR CLAUDIA CRUMP. 

IN THE TWO DECADES SINCE THAT TIME, SHE HAS CONTINUED TO BE, AS SHE WAS THEN DESCRIBED, "A LIVING EXAMPLE" OF THE BEST IN TEACHING. 
ONE OF HER STUDENTS HAS SAID "I ONLY HOPE THAT I CAN BE AS ENTHUSIASTIC, VIVACIOUS, AND INTERESTING WHEN I GET INTO THE CLASSROOM."

THIS YEAR'S RECIPIENT OF AN ALL-UNIVERSITY
TEACHING AWARD IS BILL FORSYTH, WHO SINGLEHANDEDLY CREATED THE BIOLOGY PROGRAM AT
IUS MORE THAN TWENTY YEARS AGO. SINCE
THAT TIME NEARLY THREE-QUARTERS OF THE

PROGRAM'S GRADUATES HAVE GONE ON TO GRADUATE AND PROFESSIONAL SCHOOLS IN MEDICINE, DENTISTRY, OPTOMETRY, BIOLOGY, CHEMISTRY, AND OTHER SCIENTIFIC FIELDS -- AN EXTRAORDINARY RECORD AND A TRIBUTE TO THE GREAT TEACHING OF BILL FORSYTH AND HIS COLLEAGUES.

THESE FACULTY MEMBERS REFLECT THE

TALENTS OF ALL GREAT TEACHERS AT IU

SOUTHEAST. TEACHING IS THE HEART OF OUR

UNIVERSITIES. THE CREATIVE EXCHANGE IN

THE CLASSROOM IS THE MOST REWARDING

EXPERIENCE I KNOW -- AND FEW

CORRESPONDENTS GIVE ME MORE JOY THAN MY

FORMER STUDENTS. I HOPE YOU WILL SHARE

THIS SAME PLEASURE WITH TEACHERS WHO
HAVE MADE A DIFFERENCE IN YOUR LIVES HERE

THE THIRD REALM IN WHICH EDUCATION SHOULD NEVER CEASE IS SELF. OVER YOUR UNDERGRADUATE YEARS, YOU HAVE GAINED KNOWLEDGE ABOUT YOURSELF -- PRIDE AND PLEASURE IN WHAT YOU CAN DO, UNDERSTANDING AND TOLERANCE OF YOUR LIMITATIONS. IT MAY SEEM PARADOXICAL AT FIRST, BUT THE BEST WAY TO CONTINUE LEARNING ABOUT YOURSELF IS TO HELP SOMEONE ELSE.

IN A GREAT VICTORIAN NOVEL, MIDDLEMARCH,
GEORGE ELIOT WROTE, "IF WE HAD A KEEN
VISION AND FEELING FOR ALL ORDINARY HUMAN

LIFE, IT WOULD BE LIKE HEARING THE GRASS
GROW AND THE SQUIRRELS' HEARTBEAT, AND WE
SHOULD DIE FROM THE ROAR WHICH LIES ON THE
OTHER SIDE OF SILENCE." 

I HOPE YOUR
DISCOVERIES AT IU SOUTHEAST HAVE HELPED
YOU DEVELOP "KEEN VISION AND FEELING FOR
ALL ORDINARY HUMAN LIFE."

YOU WILL NOT DIE OF THE ROAR OF LEARNING.

■ BUT ELIOT IS RIGHT THAT WITH KNOWLEDGE COMES THE LOSS OF THE GARDEN OF EDEN AND ITS INNOCENCE, AND PAIN CAN COME AS WELL. ■ PART OF THAT PAIN IS KNOWLEDGE OF THE WORLD AROUND US -- HOW MUCH SUFFERING EXISTS. ■ THE ROAR OF THAT ANGUISH CAN BE DEAFENING.
