A blank for application for
High School commission was
sent to Mr. Allen of Bluffton
several days ago, on receipt of
card from him.

I have compared the list of
commissioned High Schools on
page 57 of Mr. Bloss's report - with
the minutes of the State Board
from April 1882 to date, and
find in addition to that list
the following entered as com-
missioned: Anderson, Bedford,

and Huntington
and Bloomfield. Of those
mentioned in that list the
following only appear on the
the minutes during the
period named: Cambridge City,
Cainburg, Frankfort, Greensburg,
Indianapolis, Logansport,
Madison, Mitchell, Rockville,
Sullivan, Valparaiso, Vevay.

You will perhaps understand
why the others did not appear
on the minutes. Possibly
their commissions were
renewed, but I find no
record of such renewal. I
think, however, it would be
proper to take the printed
list in the report as proof
of renewal.
