Dear Sir: There have been several conflicting statements relative to action taken by the Faculty concerning the students found guilty of publishing and circulating that "bogus," of which so much has been said in college circles. Originally the name of J. D. Wallingford was included, but The News correspondent at Bloomington forwarded telegram, presumably by authority of you, that he was not concerned therein. Since then the Sentinel, of this city, published that he was censured for having knowledge of the plot and remaining quiet. Ft. Wayne papers are claiming that young Robertson was wrongfully accused. Will you please inform The News what was the official action of the Faculty, giving names and address of students punished, and in what way, that The News may guard against doing injustice to any one in connection with this unpleasant matter.
