To the Honorable Board of Trustees
the following report on the Department
of Romance Philology is respectfully
submitted.

The work in this department has been done
in accordance with the announcements made
in our catalogue. Professor Mr. Lake conducted
a class of fifteen students in Elementary
French and an Italian class of four students.
In my junior class six students were
enrolled and two did Senior work.

In exchange for the work done by Professor
Mr. Lake in this department I did Postgraduate
Senior and Sophomore work in the German
department; I also had, during the last term,
a class in Greek - Homer - for Professor
Haffner.

In order that we may be able to offer a

fuller course in the French department,
I would suggest the appointment of
an assistant, and I take the liberty
to add that just now we have two
graduating students in Modern Languages,
each of whom would probably do good
