I hereby present my report of the Department of Latin for the opening of the year 1890-91.

Pursuant to your election, Prof. James K. Beck formerly of the Preparatory Department, has entered upon his duties as Associate in Latin, three classes having been assigned to him. By dividing the over-crowded Sub-Freshman class, he now has four recitations.

Our numbers are as follows: Sub-Freshmen 37, Freshmen 47, Sophomores 9, Juniors 4, Seniors 1, total in the Latin Department 98. As the Juniors and Senior recite together, but the Sub-Freshmen are divided into two sections and the Freshmen into three, we have seven classes in all.

Everything is working well and the progress of the Students is generally satisfactory.
