Dear Mr. Coulter,

Several days ago, I sent you a paper containing a report of the Annual Meeting of the Indiana Branch of the Association of Collegiate Alumnae. That has given you some idea of the action of our Branch regarding the Admission of Indiana University.

As so many have claimed that Indiana University, and De Pauw have higher admission requirements than some of our colleges, I had collected the catalogues of all of our fifteen Colleges, previous to our meeting, and made

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a tabulated statement of their requirements and those of Indiana University, DePauw and Butler. I presented this at the meeting together with the memorial that I sent you and our correspondence on the subject and the substance of my talk with Dr. Ross. Mrs. Sewall and I both told all the strong and excellent features of Indiana University, that are known to us. But while recognizing all this excellence, the Branch could not see a way to explain to the Committee of A. C. A. the difference in your entrance requirements and ours. Hence we took the action reported — decided to send a memorial to the legislature, ask-

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ing them to raise the standard of
the Commissioned High Schools,
thus making it possible for Indi-
ana University to raise her stand-
ard.
