To the Local Executive Board of the
Board of Trustees;

Gentlemen,

Unanimously instructed
so to do by the Faculty, the Library Committee
of the Faculty would respectfully represent
1 That there is this year a large increase
in the teaching force of the University,
2 That there is a large increase in the
subjects taught,
3 That there is a large increase in the
number of students,
4 That the members of the University are
more widely scattered and at greater
distances in the town,
5 That a greatly increased use of the
books of reference and reserved books
is necessary, all which books must
be consulted at the Library and cannot
be drawn out, and of which the Library
has no duplicates,
6 That the facilities of the Library ought
to be made as great as possible to meet
the present demand,
and the Library Committee would therefore
on behalf of the Faculty, earnestly request

that if practicable, the daily Library
hours be extended to 5 P. M., including
Saturday.
