

# MINUTES OF THE FACULTY COUNCIL

July 24, 1956

A special meeting of the Faculty Council was held at 3:30 p.m. in the Board of Trustees' Room with President Wells presiding.

## Action of the Council

President Wells introduced Dean Cleland, Chairman of the Committee on Honorary Degrees, who presented a report recommending that the University award an honorary degree to The Right Honorable Harold Macmillan, Chancellor of the Exchequer, United Kingdom. It was proposed that the award be made at a special convocation in September 1956. President Wells explained that Mr. Macmillan was coming to Indiana in September to visit the home of his mother who was born in Indiana and spent her youth in Spencer and Indianapolis.
