## ACTIONS OF THE COUNCIL

- The Secretary be authorized to seek the services of a part-time administrative assistant to help in taking minutes of the Council 5 October 1965
- The Council endorses the proposal for an Honors Division 19 October 1965
- The present system of requesting faculty members to report midterm grades indicating unsatisfactory work be terminated except for students in the Junior Division 19 October 1965
- Endorsed President Stahr's proposal that some method of accomplishing the objectives now served by the "smoke-up" system be investigated 19 October 1965
- The half-hour credit penalty for late registration of undergraduates be stricken from the University regulations and that all statements referring to this resolution be removed from University publications 16 November 1965
- Opinion should be solicited from the Faculty about the change from the 45-minute to the 60-minute class period 7 December 1965
- Endorsement of Registrar Harrell's preference that final examination schedule be kept intact and that early examinations be allowed for potential graduates 4 January 1966
- Decisions about 60-minute class period: 18 January 1966
1. The motion of June 1, 1965, to adopt a calendar based on a 60-minute class period should be rescinded.
  2. The calendar for 1966-67 should be based on the 45-minute class period.
  3. The matter of class period change should be explored more completely by an appropriate committee.
