December 1, 1955

The Student Senate Meeting was called to order at 7:15 pm in the Bryan Room of the Union Building. There was a moment of silent prayer. Senators Greh, Hayes, Mervis, Soright, and Wagner were absent.

Senator Shelton's excuse was approved by the Executive Committee.

Senator Grinstead's resignation as Treasurer was read. Resignation adopted.

Ohio State University is having a NSA meeting on Saturday. Indiana is invited to attend.

Stan Glass, President of NSA is coming to Indiana. A special meeting will be called Monday of the Student Senate at 4:30 for his benefit.

The MRHA Board is with the Student Senate this evening.

SPECIAL COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Committee on Human Rights- Senator Deninger reported informally. His committee ~~sent~~ *sent* Senator Kimmel's resolution to the ~~two~~ *one* daily newspapers, *one weekly, Chamber of Commerce, and The Indiana Daily Student.*

Leadership Training- Senator Shelton is obtaining a movie on parliamentary procedure. It will be shown next Thursday night if the Executive committee decides to accept it.

STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Activities- Senator Yearian reported that the Activity Committee met with the Legislative Research Bureau and set up ~~three~~ *three* committees to work on evaluation of the activities on campus, according to the information blanks and constitutions. *These status will be investigated.*

Moved adoption of report. Report adopted.

Constitution- Senator Kimmel gave his report in two parts, formally ~~and~~ *and* informally. His committee met and examined the Constitution of the Big Ten Student Body President's Council, the committee deems it fitting that the Student Body President of Indiana University be a member of that Council and recommends the Constitution for passage if the Student Senate be willing to make the appropriation necessary for membership.

Senator Kimmel reported informally on the committee membership of the Elections and Petitions Committee.

Current Affairs- Senator Bassett reported informally.

Elections and Petitions Committee- Senator McCall reported that his committee voted unanimously to recommend to the Student Senate the date of Thursday, December 15, 1955, as the date of the forthcoming reballoting for the class offices still to be filled.

The Elections and Petitions Committee hereby certifies Dave Willis as the Independent Male Director of the Sophomore Class, and Delores Tracy as the Independent Female Director of the Junior Class.

Moved adoption of report. Report adopted.

Senator McCall also informally reported on the class offices that were denied the Independent candidates. All of the candidates for these offices have withdrawn their petition except that of Larry Truttier.

Chief Justice Thorsen spoke on behalf of the Court on Senator Truttier vs Junior class President.

Social, Educational, and Cultural- Senator DeVault reported informally on the Leadership of the United Nations.

Traffic and Safety- Senator Soukup reported that the Faculty Council passed the recommendation for progressive traffic fines as being 1-3-5 dollars.

Moved adoption of report. Report adopted.

OLD BUSINESS:

Senator Yearien recommended that Mike Moss read the list of organizations that did not turn in constitutions. These organizations were turned over to the Constitution Committee for necessary action.

NEW BUSINESS:

Senator Yearien reported that she received a letter from an Army Division stating they would like a picture of a co-ed to represent "Miss Home*Town".

This was submitted to the Current Affairs Committee.

Delores Tracy's resignation as Female Director of the Junior Class was read by Senator McCall. Resignation accepted.

Senator Montgomery requested permission to speak to the Senate. He requested that the ~~Election Committee~~ resubmit his name for the committee. *President of the Student Body resubmitted his name for membership of Elections and Petitions Comm.*

The Chair reminded the Senators to fill out the time they are able to work at the polls for the election of the Junior Class President.
