

INDIANA UNIVERSITY STUDENT SENATE December 13, 1956

The Indiana University Student Senate was called to order at 7:00 pame by Vice President Yenerich. Senators Blake, Capehart, Nozicka, and Schneider were absent. There was a moment of silent prayer.

EXECUTIVE BUSINESS

Linda Silver, a member of the S.E.C., spoke to the Senate of the need for inspectors for the elections, January 10. Lists were passed around for the Senators to sign at the times that would be able to work.

President Doninger spoke to the Senate on the selection of the Chief Justice. He expressed a hope that the Senate would accept his recommendation and remove the "dark cloud" from Indiana University Student Government. The recommendation for Chief Justice of the Supreme Court was FrankArvin. Senator Schmidt moved to accept this recommendation. Passed umanimously.

STANDING COMMITTERS

Activities: Senator Greenberg reported informally on discussion in the committee conserming money paid to the Union. There will be a report next meeting.

Traffic & Safety: Senator Steinberg reported he had met with Capt. Spannuth and will do so again concerning proposed street lights and stop lights.

Leadership Training: Senator Winter read the report by Senator Blake concerning a tentative program for the Leadership training program.

OLD BUSINESS

Senator Smart submitted an amendment to the Indiana University Student Government Constitution, concerning the appointment of the Chief Justice, after the bill was tabled for a week. It was moved to pass bill. Bill passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Sonator Winter sugested a need to train committee chairman as well as now Senators. He proposed to set down on paper the background and history of each respective committee by the present chairman.

Senator Winter moved to meet on January 10 instead of the first day after vacation. Passed unanimously.
