Vice President Barclay Cale called the Indiana University Student Senate to order at 7:10 in the Bryan Room. Senators absent were: Senators Lackey, Mikesell, Norman, and Pobworth. The minutes of the last meeting were approved.

EXECUTIVE BUSINESS

Mr. Pete Weston introduced Mr. Thomas Hawkins of Hampton Institute of Virginia who was a guest of the University. Mr. Hawkins spoke to the Senate and expressed interest in Indiana University Student Government.

The chair welcomed the senators-elect and the nominees for Senate to the meeting and explained the program introducing senators-elect to the Senate.

Stan Levine, Chairman of the Student Activities Co-ordination Committee, reported to Senate on the work being done by the committee in drawing up an activities booklet.

The chair read the minutes of the last Senate Executive Committee meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Senator Atkins gave the first reading of a Bill to Establish a Committee on Student Parking. The bill was referred to the Campus Welfare Committee.
