I hereby certify that I was present when Dr Wylie called upon Mr. J. C. Howe and inquired of him if he had read or recollected the purport of sundry charges made against him (Dr Wylie) by Dr Foster and especially the 8th charge which Dr Wylie read twice emphatically to Mr Howe The charge relating to duplicity & falsehood

Mr Howe observed that he was sick in bed at the time when a paper was read to him said to be charges against Dr Wylie which paper he did not read but that it was twice read and that his wife Mrs Howe signed her name thereto
