

Question of Prosecutor to Mr. Seneca

Will you please state what was done with the petition of Messrs Howe, Sumner, Sumner & Mayfield by the House of Representatives of which you were a member, and what course did the chairman of the ~~investigating~~ ^{Select} committee ^{on the affairs of the University} pursue in relation to the matter.

Ans. According to the best of my recollection a petition was introduced by Mr. Allison of Greene County relative to the State University & referred without reading to a select committee, of which my colleague, Mr. Butler, was a member. After the passage of the Joint Resolution relative to the University, the select committee reported the papers back to the House and asked to be discharged from the further consideration of the subject. I know of no other petition upon that subject, before the last House of Representatives.
