To the Hon. Jas H. Ravens
Chairman of Legislative Committee

Sir:

The undersigned, together with C. P. Hester at present unavoidably absent from Bloomington, were appointed by the Trustees of Indiana University, at their late Special Session a Committee ~~by the following resolutions~~ to "meet and receive the Committee of the Legislature."

In accordance with our instructions from the Board, we beg to state, that we hold ourselves in readiness to supply to your Committee whatever documents or other sources of information you may desire to obtain, and to aid your Committee in ~~its~~ its present investigation by every means in our power. In the meantime we submit to your Committee the records of the Board and of the Faculty, together with minutes of evidence taken during a trial of the Rev A. Wylie President of the Institution, during the special Session of the Board held in the spring of 1839.
