Dr Friend

Got home safe - up to the 29th
in business. About getting up a Paper - I

plies me with books - am about exerting
some agency, effectually, I think, to get
him & others to aid in the circulation
of your Series of School-Books - will
give them a good puff so soon as our
press gets a-going. Every thing goes by puff-
ing. So you'll please puff my Crawford-
ville address a copy of which I left on your
table. — Granny Rarky I found in a
terrible tantrum when I came home.
The cause why, is he suspected me of a design
to remove him: though in they he wronged
me: for I pitied him & resolved to bear with

all his imperfections. But jealousy is
the vice of such nature & insatiable
The beauty of it is that they compel
us to do what our pity would hold us
back from doing. — I'm looking out
