Jan 5<sup>th</sup> 1875 Faculty met for the first regular meeting of the term, Reg. Meeting at 3 P.M. Col. Thompson absent - not yet fully recovered. Prayer by Dr. Nutt, Minutes of two previous meetings approved, Mr. Sewards permitted to be examined in Rhetoric, (formerly studied) and to enter the Select, Mr. H. C. Montgomery to be permitted to take Mechanics - junior Study, Messrs Davis and White to take still  $\frac{1}{2}$  term in French in completion of their work bringing up their substitute for German, Mr. J. E. Hennepin permitted to recite without standing in Fresh. Latin - he being in Select Class and one year behind in Latin. Mr. McLoughlin reported as having brought up a term of Greek in place of a term of Fresh. Latin thus becoming regular junior, Mr. Woodburn Jr. reported as still due one term in German. Adj'd.

in the Chapel to avoid the chusing or turning with disorderly intent of persons entering the Chapel", Mr. Rod permitted to take Soph. Greek which recites at the same time as Zoology and bring up the latter study privately attending a part of the review. This gives him regular Soph. Scientific standing. Classical & Scientific Prof's to be omitted in the study of German at the fourth hour, and Mr. Baumer to read German under the direction of Prof. Ballantine.

Faculty took up the petition of the Soph. Class requesting to exchange Calculus for Latin, and decided to reply that Calculus being in the course we cannot make the changes. Adj'd

Prof Kirkwood to inform Mr. & Mrs. Schofield that our rules will not permit them being in the University Classes to recite Algebra, (in which they are deficient,) in the High School Preparatory. Messrs Davis and White to be informed by Dr. Brown that they are excused from the one half term of fees which the Faculty lately decided to be due from them. The case of the studies of Mr. Hendley (Senior) and Miss Woolverton, (Select.) was referred back to the Pres. to inquire into. It was decided that in each class we will give lessons such that an average student can get the lesson in one hour & a half. Decided that Dr Mandeville be denied the use of the Chapel after this evening Adj'd.
