Jan. 5th 1875 Faculty met for the first regular meeting of the term, at 3 P.M. Col. Thompson absent. - not yet fully recovered. Prayer by Dr. Mutt, Minutes of two previous meetings approved, Mr. Seward permitted to be examined in Rhetoric. (formerly studied.) and to enter the Select, Mr. H. C. Montgomery to be permitted to take Mechanics - Junior Study, Messrs Davis and White to take still 2 term in French in completion of their work bringing up their substitute for German, Mr. J. E. Hennepin permitted to recite without standing, in Fresh. Latin - he being in Select Class and one year behind in Latin. Mr. McLoughlin reported as having brought up a term of Greek in place of a term of Fresh. Latin thus becoming regular junior, Mr. Woodburn J. A. reported as still due one term in German. Adj'd.
