


INDIANA UNIVERSITY FACULTY MEETING

The Faculty of the University met on Tuesday, November 14, 1939, at 4 p.m. in the auditorium of the School of Business building. The reading of the minutes of the meeting of November 2, 1939, was passed by the Chairman, without objection, because a copy of the minutes had been distributed to each member of the Faculty. The copy of the minutes as distributed will be entered, by consent, in the permanent records of the Faculty except that in the eighth line from the end, the following sentence will be added. "The amended resolution was then carried."

The Chairman called on Registrar Cookson to present the calendar for 1940-41. After discussion it was moved, seconded and carried that the calendar as presented be adopted.

Chairman Payne then called on Dean Stout to present candidates for degrees from the College of Arts and Sciences. Dean Stout presented such candidates and moved that the candidates so presented be recommended by the Faculty to the Board of Trustees to be granted, subject to the record, the appropriate degrees. The motion was seconded and carried. A list of candidates was presented likewise, and the same motion made, by Dr. Carter for the Graduate School, by Dean Myers for the School of Medicine, by Professor Willis for the School of Law, by Dean Smith for the School of Education, by Dean Sanders for the School of Music and by Professor Barker for the School of Business. The motions so made, respectively, were seconded and carried.

Chairman Payne then declared that the Faculty would pass into a committee of the whole in accordance with the resolution adopted by the Faculty at its last meeting.
