

GENERAL FACULTY MEETING

INDIANA UNIVERSITY

4:00 P. M. May 29, 1941

The Faculty of the University met on Thursday, May 29, 1941 in the auditorium of the Social Science Building. President Wells presided. The minutes of the meeting of March 20, 1941 were read and approved.

President Wells then called for the presentation of the candidates for degrees in June, 1941. Lists of candidates were presented and motions were made, seconded and carried to recommend such candidates to the Board of Trustees for the appropriate degrees, by Dean Smith for the School of Education, Dean Stout for the College of Arts and Sciences, Dean Payne for the Graduate School, Dean Sanders for the Music School, Dean Badertscher for the Medical School, Dean Weimer for the School of Business, Dean Gavit for the School of Law and Mr. Cookson for the School of Dentistry. The lists of the candidates for degrees are attached to the minutes.

The President then called upon Miss Cora Hennel to report on the Susan Bulter Snow Prize for Women. Miss Hennel moved that Mrs. Ruth Ines be recommended for the award. The motion passed. Miss Hennel recommended further that some standard procedure should be adopted for the computation of grades in the selection of students for honors. It was moved and seconded that a committee be appointed to study this problem or that the matter be referred to a committee which is already at work on problems of this nature. The motion passed.

President Wells then spoke briefly concerning the Commencement procedure and also on the prospects for next year's enrollment.

Dean Stout suggested that President Wells be prevailed upon to deliver an address at the Commencement exercises. The Faculty responded with much applause.

Dean Gavit moved that a committee be appointed to draw up suitable resolutions on the loss of Judge Walter E. Treanor. The motion was seconded and carried.

The Faculty adjourned at 4:32 P. M.
