

Meeting of Feb 21-1924

A meeting of the faculty was held Feb 21, 1924 in S 32 with President Bryan in the chair.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Dean Rothrock reported a calendar for the next year. It was adopted after some discussion by the faculty as a committee of the whole.

Dean Rothrock brought up the recommendations of the Committee on Admission, which had been presented Sept 30. The recommendations were adopted.

The secretary called attention to the fact that the calendar for the present year had been modified by without faculty action by making school begin on Jan 3 instead of Jan 2, after Xmas vacation, and was given permission to change the record.

Prof May brought up the matter of students ^{not} being allowed to own automobiles. A motion to this effect failed for want of a second, and the matter was referred by the Chair to the Committee on Student Affairs.

The meeting then adjourned.
