

May 23 1922.

Meeting called by Pres. Summers. Roll Call showed Held absent. Minutes read and accepted.

Discussion upon expenses of Union Review, the amount directed to spend was gone over.

Discussion upon paying Snod for directing Review. The consensus of opinion was that he be paid for labor rendered.

Reported - J. Patton left parl room with his brother substituting for him. Moved & passed "that Committee be sanctioned to hire Patton at 26⁵⁰ per week"

Discussion on membership drive for next year. Officers given consent to go abroad and have membership cards printed. Motion & carried "That President appoint committee to make plans for 100% membership campaign for next fall - committee empowered to buy buttons & cards along with any other plans they deem necessary."

Committee - Wise - Summers - Kraus.

Report upon placards for communitarian work. Committee suggests that placards be made showing the activity of the Union. Empowered to do so.

Decided that Union Board meet with Board of Trustees

to talk over tentative plans of Union Building.

Committee to work on plans: -
Hastings (C), Adams, Nylir, Cox.
Running of pool room to be placed
at the discretion of Board members
in school this summer.

Moved & carried "To take out insurance
of \$1000 to cover furniture belonging
to Union"

Moved & carried "That Pres. & Treas
be empowered to pay J. Patten
a present for service rendered.

Not to exceed \$25 in cost.

Request to be made to Student
Affairs Comm. that they act as
permanent committee to make
calendar of student activities -
especially paid ones.

Moved & passed "That committee
be appointed to secure pictures
of athletes and suitable other
ones to be used in new Union
Building.
