Lieber reported that part of the Union scenery at Assembly Hall has been wrapped up and stored. It was decided to have all organizations who use Union scenery recognize on their programs that same is the property of and furnished by the Indiana Union.

A standing committee consisting of Lieber, Gerhart and Stahl was appointed to take care of all union property and recommend price to be charged for all rentals on theatrical property, to take an inventory of all union property and to secure plates to mark the same.

Treasurer Wells gave a financial report as of Jan 1st 1924 showing the union in good standing.

Mr. Carbin was instructed to see Mr. Hazel regarding the replacement of the union rental piano.

The meeting then adjourned.
