Pres. Tillion brought up the proposition of the American Legion Drive that is now taking place. He stated that the Y. M. C. A. had given \$50 which is to be paid through out next year.

Mr. Lieber moved that the Union Board of next year shall pay \$50 to the American Legion by January 1, 1926. Passed.

Mr. Huncilman stated that Mr. Craucher had again fallen behind on his rent. The Board is in favor of making Mr. Craucher come through or ask him to get out.
