Ringer reported on Union Open Meeting. Decided to be held Tuesday, Oct 27, 1925, 7: P. M. Ringer, Cooper, Heng, on Committee, to take care of details. A plan of stunts, talks, & ed snakes, was outlined by Com.

By consent of Board, J. Myers authorized to pay for two pages in the Arbiters.
