Mr. Cooper moved Pres. Huncilman be sent as the Board's delegate to Purdue to the Union Convention Nov 27th & 28th.

Pres. Huncilman suggested to Board Members think about the Union taking over the Jordan River Revere, and

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making it one of the Union's major activities.

Moved & passed that the Board allow a \$14.50 bill for advertising in the Red Book.
