J. Myers reports \$17.⁵⁰ profit from poolroom for last two weeks.

J. Myers reports on the insurance on furniture & fixtures. Policy was written in April, 1923, & the Ins. Co. has been carrying us for three years, approx. We have another yearly policy for 1000⁰⁰ with Woodward Co. Herbert moved that Board pay 27.⁰⁰ premium to the Ins. Agency. Seconded. Passed.

Corpus moved that Union give \$75.⁰⁰ for the purpose of helping J. M. C. B. equip reading room with magazines & papers. Seconded. Passed.

Pres. Huncilman reports H. Newcom, Pres. of Olympiad, wishes to trade a dance with the Union. Our only dance we can trade is Jan 30th 1926, after semester is ended. Union is willing to trade date of Jan 30, 1926, with Olympiads date of Mar 14th, 1926.

Pres. Huncilman put up question of the Union buying a Grand Piano, to take place of one now rented from Hoyle's Music Store for 5⁰⁰ @ ~~approx~~ month.

Decided to have Mr. Stogel put in a bill
 prais as the Student Body, and to put
 in force a fee of \$2.50 for each organization
 used, to work thru the Bursar, Mr.
 Cooper to confer with Mr. Stogel.

Pres. Hutchinson welcomed Coppage to the
 Board.

Hutchinson reported that Jordan River Res-
 ue progressing in good form.
