Meeting called to order.

Roll Call.

Minutes read & accepted.

Mr. Myers reports that money for last dance is ^{probably} at Bursar's office.

Mr. Tuttle will arrange with Murph Jones to prepare a plaque for Mr. Cogshall.

Mr. Cochran reports that matter of life membership will be attended to in the near future.

Mr. Eberhardt reports that Richardson wants to get a check on the barbers for one week.

Mr. Tombaugh reports that money from last dance is probably in hands of Bursar.

Mr. Huncilman reports signs, etc are ready for distribution.

Mr. Tombaugh agrees to break contract with Crimson Senenaders for Jan 30th. Crimson Senenaders are to play the dance Feb 5th.

Pres. Huncilman brot up question of a Charleston Dance in the Trophy Bldg. Pres. Huncilman had the Board's consent to inquire further into the possibility of giving such a dance.

Mr. Tombaugh reports that he will either buy or return a ring belonging to the Union now in his possession. Pres. decided to take matter with Prof. Cogshall. Ex Board consented to leave the matter up to him.

Pres. reports that Chas. Hays says he has a plan to put a rail in front of check room, if Union will stand the expense. Pres. brot up the idea that Union could take over the checking for all dances. Mr. Rust

moved that matter of Union taking over
 all checking of clothing in Student Bldg,
 & perhaps all others, be attempted.
 seconded. Passed. Pres. Huncilman to see
 Deans & possibility of going ahead.
 Mr. Rust brot up question of lighting effects in
 the Student Bldg. Pres. left up to Mr.
 Tombaugh to get lights subdued at next dance.
 Mr. Tombaugh agrees to collect the \$2.00 fees from
 the deans office.
 Mr. Cooper reports he has order 1000 blanks
 decks made out to Union for \$4.00.
 Mr. Tombaugh suggests that between the halves
 at basket-ball games something be done
 to entertain the crowd, as boxing matches.
 etc. Mr. Eberhardt appointed to look into
 the matter.
