The treasurer reported that the last dance netted a profit of \$64.¹⁵, the pool room during the last week \$12.²⁵ and that 5 new memberships had been secured.

Mr. Rector was appointed to investigate prices and possibilities of installing a phone on first floor of Student Building.

The president said that alphabetical lists of memberships would be made for use at dances and in pool room.
