

September 13, 1927

Roll Call - Jones, Ramsey, Spurgeon absent. Minutes last meeting, May 24, read & approved.

Vice Pres. Clark reports on membership campaign in which 350 members secured, but due to failure of I.V. Trustees to inform Union board, all men in University already being members due to increase in fees, it will be necessary to refund the money collected in the opening campaign. 50 cents of the \$2.50 fee increase goes to make Union treasury, making all men registered members of Union.

It is decided that a membership recognition card be distributed to men on paying fees next semester.

Pres. Ringier presents following bills.

Hayes, sup. grounds, \$3.00 Window & Floor cleaning, ^{Passed} L.C. Balfour Co - 1925 Union bills \$165.00.

Motion made & carried to allow this bill.

Archie Warner - Campaign cards & ads - 3.00 (passed)

Guthrie & Co - Sec's stamps 2.50 (passed)

Plans for a dance on night of Saturday, Sept 17 discussed. It was decided to employ Hotstad's orchestra at special rate of \$71.00.

Pres. Ringier appoints Wahl, Redding, Foreman as committee to assist V. Pres. Clark at dance.

There was no report from pool room committee.

In a discussion of plans for the year, general opinion was that Union attempt to foster duties formerly of Boosters Club & Olympiad. The Union will not manage gridgraph unless it can be purchased, because of the pending account against Boosters Club.

Pres Ringier suggests ^{for future discussion} a house president plan as a means for better cooperation between Union & unorganized men, and as a means for reaching such men. Discussion Postponed.
