Gridgraph for M.W. games. Donnell, informs Ringer he will consult with Craven regarding University purchase Board for £50. Clark moved that it be suggested to University officials that they purchase board, & allow Union to operate it, turning profits back to University. ^{Consent} Ringer to confer with V.H. Smith in this regard.

Discussion of dance for Nov 5. Motion made that dance be held employing Gunstead's Orchestra. Carried.

It was suggested that Union endorse movement on campus & have time of Capt. G. Chace extended, so as to retain him as Band Director. A motion made & Carried that Board officials draw up a resolution to effect that efforts be made to retain Capt. Chace ^{for a year} & present said resolution to University Trustees.

Ramsey appointed to compile and secure list of negro men students, & arrange to refund Union fees paid by them, through Bureau's office.

Ringer reports he is to confer with Athletic officials regarding holding of pep meeting, and will report their views to Board at next meeting.
