

Nov 15 [1927]

Minutes of Nov 8 read and approved.

Wall reports pool-room conditions O.K. Suggested that Potter, custodian be authorized to handle all small bills arising thru operation of Pool room, rather than handling through Treasurer.

Jones reported Charles Hays in favor of allowing Assembly Hall to be used for dances if permission is secured from University Executive Committee. Hays also said floor would require large wash and sanding in order to be suitable for dancing. The probable cost being between \$100 - \$200. Jones was authorized by the board to get estimates on cost of refinishing the floor.

No definite report from telephone or negro for refund committees.

Gudgraph report on Northwestern game - deficit of approximately \$11.85 less capital outlay on board for electric bulbs of \$13.86.

Ringer reported having successfully negotiated for the purchase of the Gudgraph board for \$200. Of the amount, \$181.14 was requisitioned from University Union fund, the balance paid from Union account. It was decided that the old notes on the Gudgraph be turned over to the University for safe keeping.

Ringer reported plans for a pep-meeting for Friday night, preceding the Purdue game & be under way. Mens Panhellenic Council to work in conjunction with Union Board in sponsoring the meeting, and in attempting to prevent property damage.

It was reported that the athletic department would divide expenses with the Union in providing red and white cloth for the formation of an I cheering section at the Purdue game.

Approximate estimates put this cost at about \$35.00. A motion was made that Union agree & pay 1/2 of such cost. This motion was amended to read - Union to agree & pay 1/2 the cost, up to the limit of \$20 on the part of the Union. Motion carried.

Discussion was taken up regarding the present plans and possibilities of the new Union Building. Redding was appointed to investigate present status, and report to Union board.

After discussion, it was decided that the Union should not hold a dance Friday night before the Purdue game.

Due to the fact that Shanko giving vacation begins Wed. Nov. 23, little need was seen for a meeting Nov 22. A motion was made seconded and carried to adjourn until Tues. Dec. 27.

(Insert) In regard to means for passing out the song and yell circulars at the Purdue game, it was suggested that those men who work in removing the gridgraph board from the stage of assembly hall, be given work of passing out bills, and paying them \$1.00 each. A motion, in above terms, was made and carried. The treasurer was authorized to make out a check covering those wages.
