Champ, Bunker, Ray & Spurgeon absent. Minutes of Nov 15, and Nov 21 read and approved.

James reports on assembly hall. Charles Hays is to make an estimate and present it to University executive committee. James to continue with investigation report on telephone installation.

Was decided that no dance be held this weekend ~~due~~ to other open dances on campus at that time.

The Union having a Student Body reunion for Jan 14, the advisability of booking an orchestra for that date discussed. On account of possible conflict with other activities on that date, it was suggested that the date be changed to Jan 6 or 7. Ring announced that a band from Louisville could be secured on one of those dates for \$25, it having other engagements in Bloomington the same week end.

Motion was made that the Louisville band be booked for that date, for a dance in Trophy room or in assembly hall, if that place was in condition by then. Carried.

Redding reported having investigated present status of proposed new Union Building arrangements. Thompson estimated that Building may be started in next 3 years.

In consideration of that fact, it was suggested that the Union purchase new furniture for the present Board room. A motion was made that the president appoint a committee to investigate and get bids on prices of new chairs for the room. This motion carried. Ramsay, Richardson, Redding, Professors Cogshall & Truitt appointed.

A bill for \$3.50 for signs payable to R. Bremer was announced unpaid. This bill authorized to be paid if found to be valid.

It was announced that due to mis understandings, ~~as men~~ the men who ~~were~~ worked removing gridgraph, had not reported to pass out bills & songs & yells at Purdue Game. It was ~~unreal~~ ~~undoubtedly~~ carried that these men be paid 50 cents each who worked on gridgraph, and \$4.00 to the man who worked ~~on~~ gridgraph and reported for service at the Purdue game. The remainder of the 2.50 from the total previously authorized for this purpose is to go to Clark for his services.

Wall reported having expended \$1.50 for telephone calls in booking orchestras. It was moved that Wall be reimbursed by treasurer Motion Carried.

Ringer presented bill for 80 cents, charges for sending telegram to Chicago at Chicago game Bill allowed.

Ringer announced he was leaving ^{this week end} for the convention of University Ymca at Iowa City and welcomed any suggestions for questions he might bring up at that convention. Adjournment 8 P.M.
