Roll call Champs Ramsey, Ray, Spurgeon absent
Minutes Feb 21 read and approved.

Redding brought up the bill of \$1.00 from Yellow
Tapi Co. ^{Sept 14} Was found that the Tapi's rendered no
service at that time. Was recommended that the bill
be not paid.

For the yell leader committee, Redding reports that a
Trophy Co. with which he conferred suggested a trophy
cups as a reward to yell leader. Another company
suggested a bronze plaque, and sent a sketch of
such a plaque. The committee recommended that
this plaque be approved as a reward, subject to
further acceptance by Capt. Chaver. As to the
method of choosing such yell leaders as are
to be awarded such plaque, this is to be left
to discretion of the committee and Capt. Clever.
A motion made to accept the plaque ^{as represented} as the
award to be adopted. Motion carried.

Wall reports having begun arrangements
for pool and billiard tournament. Permission
was granted Wall to have posters made advertising
the event. The date for this tournament
was discussed, and by recommendation of
Wall and motion, it was agreed to hold the
tournament March 12 and 13.

A dance had been ~~arranged~~ scheduled for
Mar 3. Due to a large number of house
dances, and a dance by Scabbard & Blade
on that week end, it was agreed not to
hold a dance on night of Mar 3. Ringer
reported having contracted with band for
Union dance of Mar 31.

Wall suggested that dates be allowed. Freshman Class
Due to fact that Union has only one free date, ^{March} April 21,
this date to be retained, and Wall authorized to

arrange with freshman and allow them to find another date.

Ringer reports a bill of \$50 from Charles Hays for the decorations at assembly hall for Boilermakers Ball. Bill approved.

Complaints having been registered against the condition of the floor in assembly hall, Jones asked permission to confer with Hays as to method of improving the floor. Jones was authorized to proceed with investigation.

Was suggested that covers be put on new chairs to prevent their being marred by contact with walls. Was agreed by consent of the board that proper care be taken of the chairs, and so no covers would be necessary.

The matter of election of the new Union Board for next year was brought up. According to the constitution, the nominating committee is named by Deans of men & board faculty members. Cogshall agreed to take charge of arranging this meeting of faculty members & the Deans.
