Roll Call. Jones, Ramsey, Ray, Spurgeon absent.
Minutes Feb 28 read & approved

Redding reported having ordered the plaque which was decided upon as the reward to yell leaders. The plan for choosing the yell leader to whom the plaque would be presented, is to have a committee composed of Capt. Charn, Dean Edmondson and a representative from the Union board select the man to whom the award should be given. It was suggested that the present Union board have representation in making this award.

Wall reported having arranged for the pool and billiard tournament, and having had posters made advertising the event. It was decided to allow Wall to make all specific arrangements and care for details of rules governing the tournament.

No report on the booking attempt & book performances was made, Ray chairman of the committee being absent.

Discussion of Union Board picture was brought up. It was decided to put in pictures of all members including any who served only one semester, ~~this included~~ Under this provision the pictures of Clark for the first semester, and Dawson for the second semester will be included, their respective terms being designated on the picture.

Prof. Cogshall reported that the faculty committee which would appoint the nominating committee would meet soon. It asked that the present board members suggest names of seniors who might be considered for appointment on nominating committee.

It being necessary, under the Union Constitution for the Board to elect one faculty member, discussion was opened as to whom might be appointed. Prof. Cogshall was nominated in that capacity. A motion was made to close the nominations, motion carried & Cogshall unanimously elected.

Wall brought up request from Freshman class that Union allow them the use of one of the Union's scheduled social dates. Due to small number of dates remaining for the Union, it was decided that the Union retain its present scheduled dates.

Because of a conflict of dates, a Republican Club banquet being scheduled for night of March 13, it was decided that no Union Board meeting be held on that date, next week. It was agreed that present board members turn in names of suggested members for next year's board to Ringer before next Friday.
