Minutes March 20 read & approved.

Wall reported pool tournament not yet completed due to absence of several participants. The tournament to be completed as soon as possible.

Arrangements for the dance of March 31, are proceeding. Wall has arranged for chaperons and made agreement with "L." men's association to pay 1/2 the charge of decorations which will be put up for the dance of that evening on Friday night and retained for the Union dance Saturday night. This action was approved by the board.

In regard to the use of the Union's funds in treasury, Prof Cogshall suggested that part of money be invested in bonds, and kept for future use in new Union Building. This met with approval of the board.

The necessity of holding an open meeting to elect the officers for next year's board, brought forth discussion of time for such a meeting. The Tuesday night, April 3 was suggested.

Plans put forward for such an meeting included smoker, with send off of the baseball team, speeches by Limbrow and other entertainment in nature of orchestra etc.

Redding appointed chairman, with Forkner to assist, and committee to make complete arrangements for the open meeting.

Further discussion of arrangements followed. Full authority to proceed being put left to the Committee for open meeting.

Pres. Ringer made a proposal that the Union compile a small booklet, such as that which might be used by A. W. S. for the women, for the distribution to men at the beginning of the school year in September. Such a

booklet might contain information regarding University functions, athletic schedules, house directory, library rules, the Union and its functions and the revised constitution of the Union. Another proposal by Mr. Ringer is to have the Union constitution ~~rewritten~~ and revised. revised and rewritten. This proposal to receive further consideration at the next board meeting, which will follow the open meeting Tues. night.

On the proposition of the dance for April 21, following the Prom, various suggestions were put forth, including that to secure a good band for that dance. Wall was given authority to investigate and report possibilities. By consent of Board, a limit of cost of band for that dance at \$200.
