Minutes April 16 read & approved

Pres. Ring reported receipts of dance April 21 were about \$20 meaning a loss on the dance of about \$100. The chief reason advanced for poor attendance was the unsuitability of the floor of assembly hall for dancing purposes.

Redding made known the plans for the Union open meeting, definitely scheduled for May 3, Student Bldg. It was decided that no meeting of the Board be held on the regular meeting night of May 1, but that a meeting be held following the open meeting at which time the newly elected Board will be installed.

Discussion arose as to the advisability of the Union publishing a general information booklet for distribution at registration time in September to all men. The fact that the Y. M. C. A. publishes a freshman guide and the Reed-Book, it was suggested that an effort be made to cooperate in some manner with the Y. M. C. A. rather than to duplicate the work of that organization. Although joint publication of a booklet was not deemed advisable, this matter left open for further consideration after conference with Y. M. C. A. secretary.

A bill of \$2.50 to Branigan for posters advertising the open meeting was allowed.

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
