Deitsch gives a short account of the matters dealt with at the Natl Assn of College Union's Convention and reports that a type-written report of the meetings of the Natl Student Federation of America is being prepared. The ason representative sent to this convention by the Union has submitted his statement of expenses which Forkner has paid. Dawson, on behalf of the asons, extends their appreciation to the Union Board for paying the expenses of ~~athletic~~ representative. to this convention

Deitsch reports that the dance date has been changed from Jan 18th to the 19th. Moved that Astor band be secured if possible, + if this not possible, that an out of town orchestra be obtained which will not cost over \$115⁰⁰

Jones app's to see Smith and obtain permission to use University materials for decorating for the dance. Hall + Ramsey app's to secure officials of the Athletic Dept, + other officials for chaperones.

Moved that several ads be placed in the Purdue "Exponent".
Motion seconded + carried.

Dawson app's to get a list of the organizations at Purdue, + their addresses so that cards advertising the dance may be sent to them. Sec'y appointed to have these cards mimeographed and sent out.

Invitations to the dance to be sent to Gov. + Mrs Leslie, and to the members of the Legislature.
