Roll call - Minutes of Feb 19th read & approved.

Moved that the Union have a radio placed in Assembly Hall Monday from 10 to 12 o'clock for the inaugural ceremony, provided the University dismisses school for those hours. ^{Motion seconded & carried and} Jones appointed to secure the radio.

Mullins reports having seen Cleaver about the yell leader award, & following Cleaver's suggestion it was moved that Deitsch appoint a committee composed of Cleaver, McCoy, and a Union Board ~~Committee~~ members to select the man to whom the award is to be given. Motion seconded & carried.
