Mullins reports having seen Cleaver about the yell leader award, & following Cleaver's suggestion it was moved that Deitsch appoint a committee composed of Cleaver, Mc Coy, and a Union Board ~~Committee~~ member to select the man to whom the award is to be given. Motion seconded & carried.
