Roll call. Minutes read, corrected, and approved.

1. Treasurer's Report;

1. Pool room made \$48.50 last week.

Bills + Disbursements:

1. Request from N.S.F.A. to pay annual dues of 2¢ per student enrolled in I.V. Submitted to Murphy for investigation before being allowed; Murphy to ascertain precisely what functions of N.S.F.A. are.

Dance:

1. Shift of dance date to Nov. 7 advocated; and, being considered desirable, was voted to be procured if possible.

Officers changed:

1. Tucker installed by acclamation to office of secretary created by Jones, outgoing fountain of verbiage. Ben Miller & Frank Pope nominated for vacancy created by Tucker's removal from the "rank & file" to the secretary's chair; both men to be ~~nominated~~ voted on at following meeting.

Concession:

1. Question of reducing pop prices from 10¢ to 5¢ discussed. Stuhville to ascertain whether prices may legitimately be reduced.

Melrose:

1. Secretary to write U. + C. Song Book Co. expressing regret at Union's inability to give permission to publish I.V. song; for Union & Melrose Pub. Co. have contract by which ^{perhaps} Union's ~~can't~~ granting such permission.

Yell Committee:

1. Voted, that Union purchase cards for accentuating color effects of roasting section at N.W. game.
