Treasurer reported that pool room operated at gross profit $\$46^{00}$ for week ending Mar. 4, 1937. That dance held Mar. 4, operated at figure of $\$45$ gross, $\$30$ of which was given to band after deducting $\$15^{00}$ for expenses.

Also reported that after paying $\$25^{00}$ to Y.M.C.A. for magazine subscriptions and $\$26^{40}$ to Daily Student for advertising, a bank balance resulted of $\$37^{28}$.

The Board approved minor bills of amounts $\$1^{25}$ for taxi fare to checker, Cab Co., and can of wax bill to Varsity Pharmacy = $\$1^{25}$. Also another bill for adv. to Daily Student for $\$9^{00}$ was approved.

R. Alsop was placed in charge of the annual pool tournament after favorable discussion re: its continuance.

Owing to a bicentennial celebration, it was decided to forego a dance scheduled for March 11.
