Dean Merrill, and William Madigan gave a short talk on the Music series plan and it was decided that each member select a helper and assignments were to be made Monday noon as to what houses to attend. Moved, seconded that the Union Music Series tickets be payable on or before Dec 15. Byron, Fletchal, and Ral were authorized to present a plan to Dean of Women that the interfraternity council be barred from having Friday night dances and also that the budget for dance bands at each individual fraternity be reduced, as an increase in same would raise price of Union dance bands.

Fletchall appointed Biddinger, Keisler and Hornbostel on pep session committee for the Notre Dame game.

Ralston was instructed to write and thank Pleiades, Sphinx Club, and the Band for their cooperation in Pep Session Friday Sept 29th, Plans were discussed for staging a big pep session the night before the Notre Dame game.
