

BEGINNING OF NEW BOARD OF CONTROL 1934-35

April, 12, 1934

Roll Call: All were present.

Director Ward G. Biddle presiding over the meeting, he proceeded announce the floor open for nominations for president.

Charles Hornbostel and Milton Fineberg were nominated.

Hornbostel elected.

Robert Porter and Kenneth King were nominated for vice-president and Porter was elected.

Robert Keck and Clarence Elliott were nominated for secretary. Keck was elected.

No business could be conducted at this meeting called by the Director as stated in the Constitution. Charlie Hornbostel, president elect, stressed the importance of the work to be done next year. Robert Porter spoke briefly concerning plans for the coming year. Director Biddle told of the Union Board history and of the convention of college Unions to be held here at Indiana next fall. He analyzed the organization of the Union and stressed the seriousness of the work ahead.
