Roll Call: Robinson, Heighway, and Feltus were absent.

Minutes of the last meeting read and approved.

Receipts Nos 3457-3486 and Bills Nos 870-876 were read. Moved and seconded that they be accepted as read. Carried.

Billiard committee reported that plans were well under way for the Venable-Edmondson billiard match next Monday and Tuesday evenings. Picture committee reported that all pictures were being made and will be put up immediately. Eight pictures are being made in all.

Dir. Biddle announced that \$72.41 was left in the dance fund treasury. This was considered enough for the free dance to be given by the Board May 24th.

Fineburg announced that the Constitution committee would meet several times during the summer.

Moved and seconded that the Union reimburse Dr. Beck to the extent of \$25 for his expenditures in connection with the open-forums this past year. Carried.

Fineburg announced that plans were being formulated for next year's forums. He also stated that reservation had been made in the social calendar for both the football and basketball banquets next year. They each will take place the first Monday after the season for each sport.

Moved and seconded that the Union secure December 6th for the first formal dance of the year. Carried.

Fineburg appointed Vercuski and Keck to contact Blue Key on the possibility of the Union sponsoring the Victory dance after the Purdue game. He appointed Fox, Walker, and Stout on the calendar committee. They are to draw it up immediately.

He also appointed Harrell, Huffman, Briggs to investigate the possibility of eliminating ex-AWS board members from attending Union dances gratis.

Meeting adjourned 8:35 pm.
