Harrell moved that a committee be appointed to draw up a set of house rules and penalties, and that such be posted in the building. Seconded and carried. Fineburg appointed Fixler, Stout, Harrell, and Walker on the house rules committee.

Briggs was instructed to see about securing a bullitin board for the Commons for Union news.
