Briggs reported that 350 were present for the last open forum. Prof. Willis will conduct the next forum, April 7th, on "Is a Supreme Court Supreme?"

Robinson told of the crime conference to be held on the campus next week.

Harrell moved that the Board aid Robinson in every way possible in the taking of finger prints among the students and townspeople. Seconded and carried.

Fineburg appointed Briggs, Harrell, Emmons, Smithburn, Fixler, Stout to aid Robinson.

Fineburg appointed Vercuski, Stout, Fox, Cogshall, and Smithburn on the election committee to function immediately.

Fox moved that the Union membership cards not be required as a requisite to voting in the Union election, April 1st. Seconded and carried.

Charles C. Peterson presented the Board with an ivory gavel in appreciation for his enjoyable visits at Indiana University. He stated that he will take care of all challengers to Dean Edmondson's faculty billiard title.
