Information was presented to the Board concerning the Chess Club. Church was appointed as the Board member to assist with the undertakings of the organization.

Discussion ensued as to the advisability of the Union sponsoring a Flying Club. Herdrich was appointed to secure information on the proposal.

Dir. Patrick read financial report for fiscal year ended June, 1937. Masters moved that the report be accepted. Seconded and carried.

Ham read a letter from Andrew Olafson concerning the use of the public address system during Grid-Graph presentations this year. It was decided to install the system for such presentations.

Greiger was appointed to have charge of Grid-Graph operations for the out-of-town football games.
